Revenues for providers such as AWS, Microsoft, and Google will be reported in the public cloud services markets, whereas portions of offerings such as HPE GreenLake, AWS Outposts, Microsoft Azure Stack, and Oracle Cloud@Customer will be reported in the dedicated infrastructure as a service.
